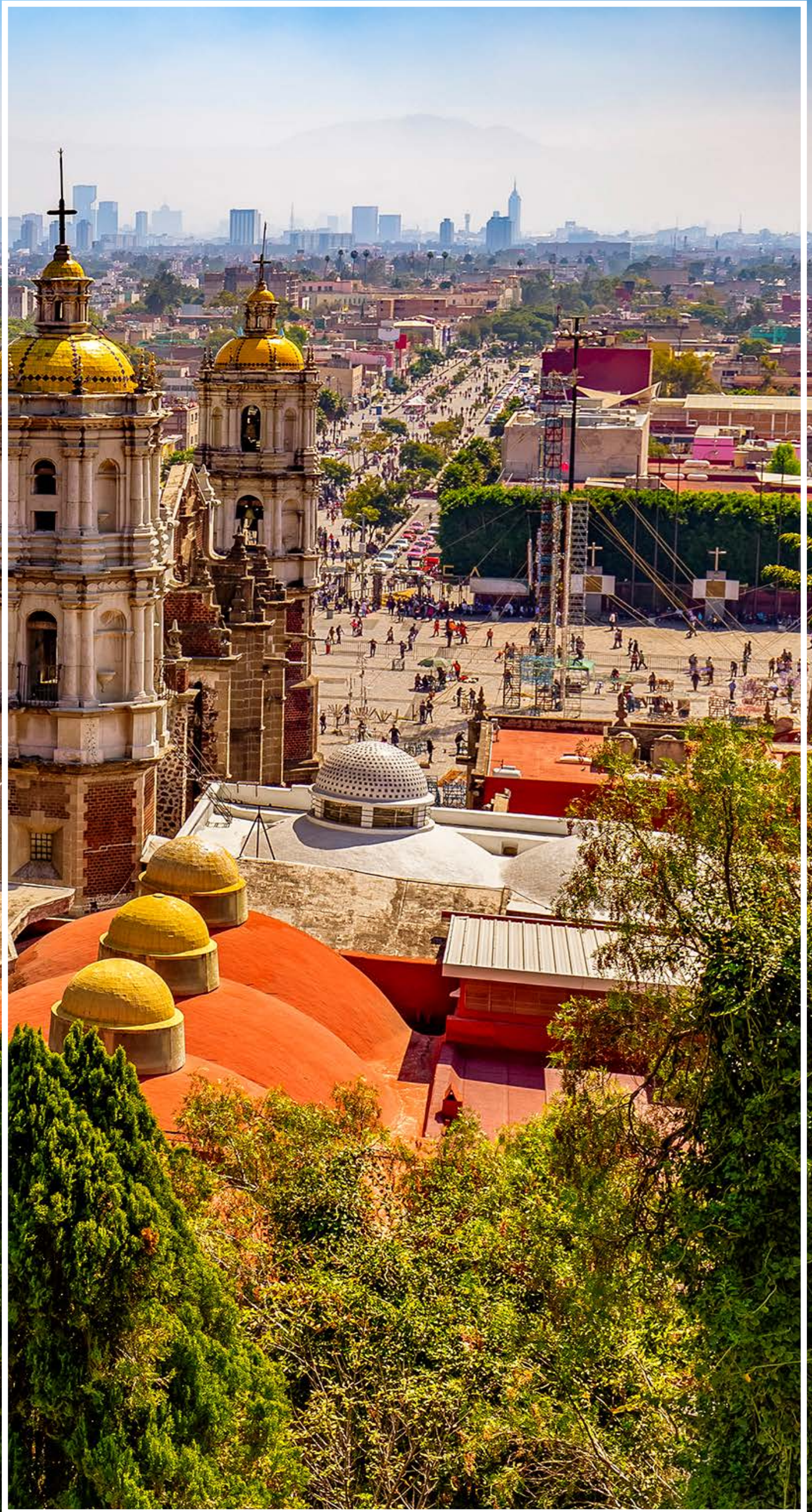

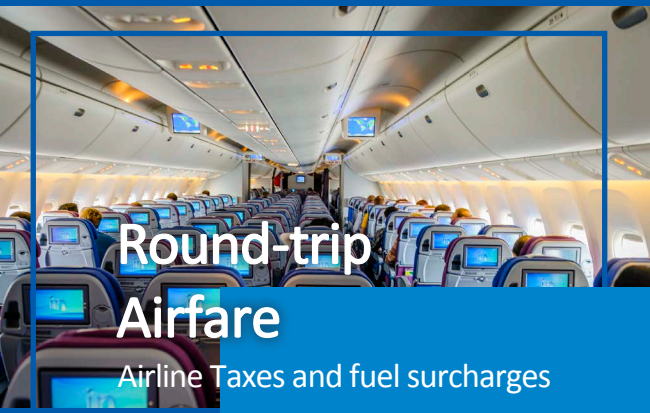

The Ciudad de México, CDMX, is the capital of Mexico, the United Mexican States. It's also the most populous city in North America. Located entirely within the Valley of Mexico, the altitude is 2,240 meters (7,350 ft), although many parts of the city are somewhat higher. The city is composed of 16 boroughs, since 2016, known as alcaldias.

Friday, June 14, 2024

Los Angeles/Mexico City

Our journey to Mexico begins as we depart Los Angeles on AM647 at 11:40 am on our non-stop flight to Mexico City. Arrive in Mexico City at 4:20 pm, where we will be welcomed by our guide and bus driver and start our drive through Mexico City to our hotel. Rest of the afternoon at leisure.

Saturday, June 15, 2024

Mexico City/Museum of Anthropology

Our full day in Mexico City will take us to the Plaza of the Three Cultures and drive through Paseo de la Reforma, a broad avenue across the heart of Mexico City. We passed many monuments, including Palacio de Artes, ancient buildings, and churches. At the Zocalo, the largest square in Mexico, we see the Metropolitan Cathedral, National Palace, and Aztec Ruins. After lunch (included), we visited the famous National Museum of Anthropology.



Sunday, June 16, 2024

Xochicalco/Taxco

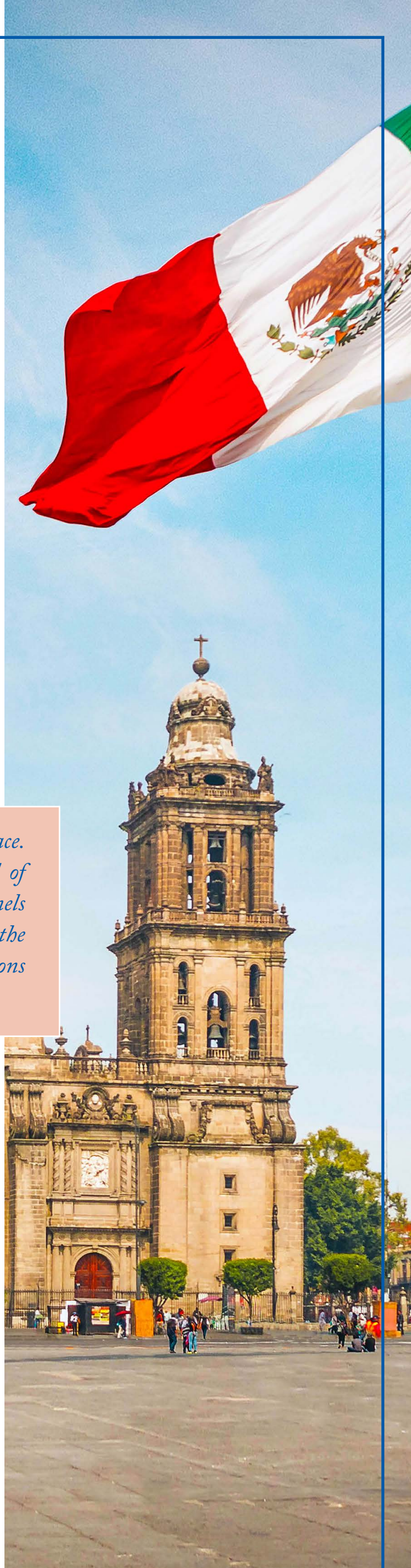
Depart Mexico to Xochicalco, a well-preserved fortified city once a political, religious, and commercial center. We visit the fortified outstanding town built on top of a mountain. We will now move on to Cacahuamilpa National Park, where one of the largest cave systems in the world is located. Continue to Taxco, a picturesque colonial town in the Guerrero area of Mexico that made its fortune through silver mining. We take small taxis to downtown (it is uptown) to walk the cobblestone streets and see the center with the many attractions. Please return to our hotel in Mexico City.

Xochimilco, a UNESCO World Heritage Place. Xochimilco, which in Nahuatl means 'Field of Flowers', outstands by a series of rain channels existing since pre-Columbian times, when the Valley of Mexico was full of lakes and lagoons almost entirely.

Monday, June 17, 2024

Coyoacan/Xochimilco

This morning, we visit the suburb of Coyoacan, famous for its cobblestone streets and colonial architecture, and then continue to Xochimilco for a tour of the canals aboard a traditional boat, where we enjoy a festive atmosphere with music, shopping, and lunch on board the "trajinera". It's time to shop before returning to our hotel in Mexico City.



The holy city of Teotihuacan ('the place where the gods were created') is situated some 50 km north-east of Mexico City, with its monuments – in particular, the Temple of Quetzalcoatl and the Pyramids of the Sun and the Moon. This magnificent place bears unique testimony to the pre-urban structures of ancient Mexico.

Tuesday, June 18, 2024

Teotihuacan/Shrine of Guadalupe

The ancient Mesoamerican city of Teotihuacan is in a sub-valley of the valley of Mexico. It is known as the site of the most architecturally significant Mesoamerica pyramids built by pre-Columbian Americans, namely the Pyramid of the Sun and the Pyramid of the Moon. We see both pyramids and may walk from one to the other. Please check with the tour guide about the possibility of a early morning Hot Air Balloon Flight over Teotihuacan (optional, approximate cost per person is \$120). Return to Mexico City and stop at the impressive complex and Mexico's holiest shrines, Our Lady of Guadalupe

Wednesday, June 19, 2024

Mexico City/Los Angeles

Transfer to Mexico City airport to take our AM flight 642 departing Mexico City airport at 1:45 PM, arriving in Los Angeles at 4:44pm.

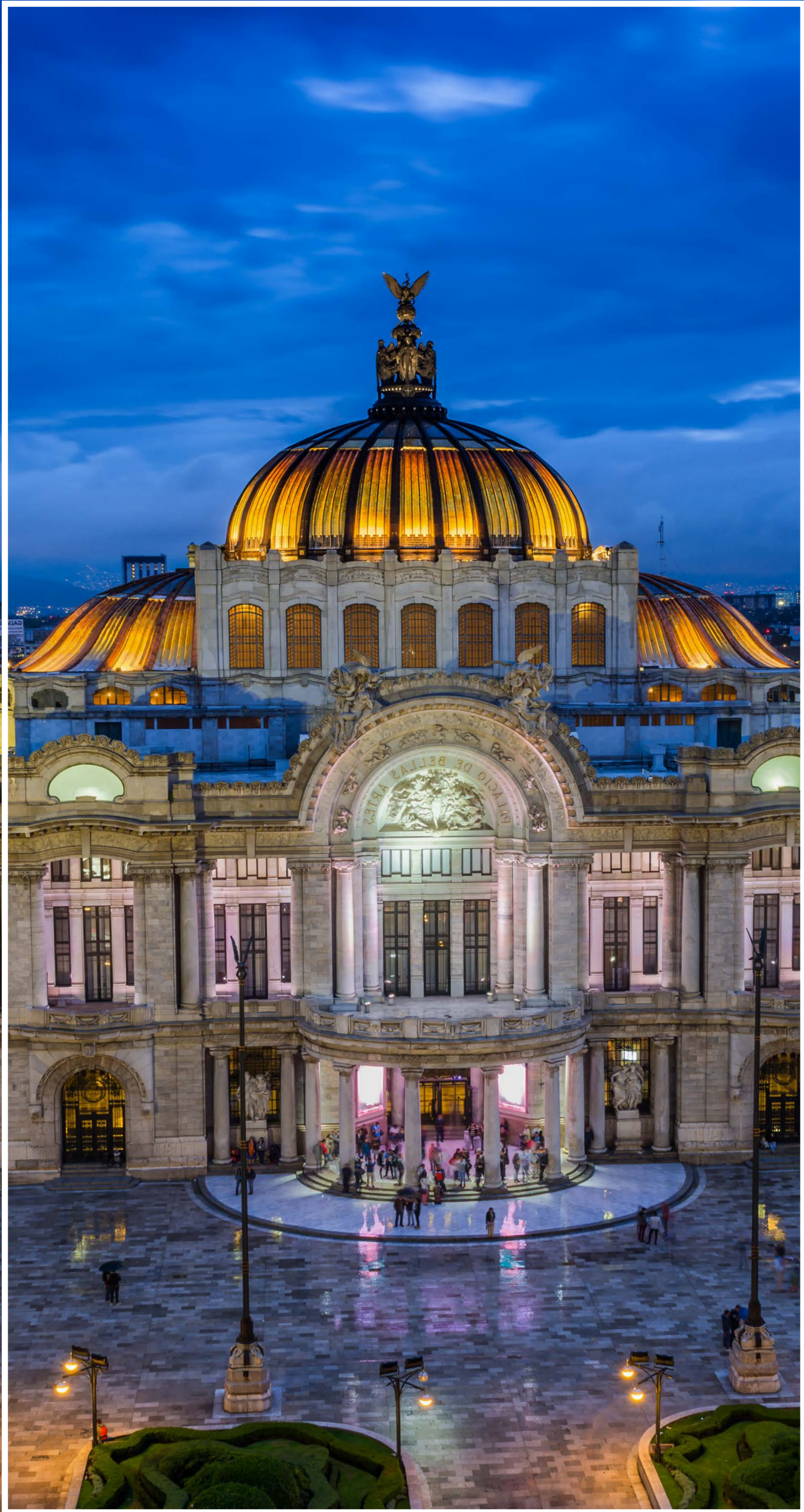
